What is paraphrasing?	Paraphrasing means expressing the same ideas in different words.
Why is paraphrasing important?	It helps in understanding and conveying information accurately.
How do you paraphrase different types of media?	Different media (text, video, charts) require different approaches to paraphrasing.
What are common mistakes in paraphrasing?	Common mistakes include repeating text verbatim and thinking only written text can be paraphrased.
How can you improve your paraphrasing skills?	Practice with diverse media and compare original and paraphrased versions to improve skills.
