Why are concrete details	
important?	Concrete details make writing more vivid and help the reader understand the topic better.
How do quotations enhance writing?	Quotations provide authority and credibility to the writing.
What types of information can develop a topic?	Facts, definitions, concrete details, quotations, and examples can all develop a topic.
How to evaluate the relevance of details?	Evaluate details by checking if they directly support the main idea and are relevant to the topic.
