What is precise language?	Precise language means using exact and accurate words to convey your message.
Why is domain-specific	Denote the second to the second to the second secon
vocabulary important?	Domain-specific vocabulary refers to terms that are specific to a particular field or subject.
How does precise language improve writing?	Using precise language makes your writing clearer and more effective.
Examples of domain-specific vocabulary	Examples: 'photosynthesis' in science, 'democracy' in social studies.
Common misconceptions	Misconception 1: More complex words are always better. Misconception 2: Domain-specific vocabulary is only for technical subjects.
