Cues	Notes
What is reliable information?	Reliable information is accurate and trustworthy.
How do you evaluate sources?	Evaluate sources by checking the author's credentials, publication date, and site's domain.
What is paraphrasing?	Paraphrasing is rephrasing information in your own words.

	Note-taking helps organize and retain information.
How do you categorize information?	Categorize information by grouping related ideas together.
