What is text evidence?	Text evidence is information from a text that supports your analysis.
Why is text evidence important?	Text evidence makes your arguments stronger and more credible.
How do you cite text evidence?	To cite text evidence, use direct quotes, paraphrases, or summaries with clear references to the source.
What are direct quotes?	Direct quotes are exact words taken from the text and put in quotation marks.
What is paraphrasing?	Paraphrasing is rephrasing the text in your own words while keeping the original meaning.
