What are conjunctions?	Conjunctions link clauses or phrases (e.g., and, but, or).
What are prepositions?	Prepositions show relationships between nouns and other words (e.g., in, on, at).
What are interjections?	Interjections express emotions (e.g., wow, ouch, hey).
How do they function in sentences?	They help create complex sentences and convey precise meanings.
Examples of each	Examples: 'and' connects ideas, 'in' shows location, 'wow' expresses surprise.
