What is a series?	A series is a list of three or more items.
Why use commas in a series?	Commas separate items to avoid confusion.
What is the Oxford comma?	The Oxford comma is the comma before 'and' or 'or' in a series.
How does punctuation affect clarity?	Proper punctuation makes writing clearer and easier to understand.
Examples of lists in writing	Grocery lists, to-do lists, descriptive sentences, recipes.
