What are Greek and Latin roots?	Greek and Latin roots are the basic parts of many English words.
	Roots give clues to the meaning of a word.
How do roots help us understand words?	Prefixes and suffixes modify the meaning of the root.
What are common prefixes and suffixes?	Context helps determine the exact meaning of a word.
Why is context important?	Examples: 'photo' means light, 'graph' means to write.
