| What are main ideas? | Main ideas are the central points of a text. |
| How to identify key details? | Key details support and elaborate on the main ideas. |
| Why is summarizing important? | Summarizing helps distill information to its essence. |
| Common misconceptions? | Misconception: First sentence is always the main idea. |
| Real-world applications? | Misconception: Summarizing is just paraphrasing. |
