## Today's Standard

What is the standard 5.RI.7?	5.RI.7 is about using multiple sources to quickly find answers or solve problems.
Why is evaluating sources important?	Evaluating sources ensures the information is reliable and accurate.
How can you locate information quickly?	Use library catalogs, online databases, and reference materials to find information efficiently.
What is paraphrasing?	Paraphrasing means putting information into your own words to show understanding.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking all sources are reliable and that copying is the same as understanding.
