What is collaborative discussion?	Collaborative discussions involve engaging with others to share and build on ideas.
Why is active listening important?	Active listening helps understand others' viewpoints and contributes to effective discussions.
How can we express our ideas clearly?	Expressing ideas clearly involves organizing thoughts and speaking respectfully.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions: thinking differing ideas are not valuable, and believing that speaking more equals effective participation.
