Cues	Notes
Linking Words	Linking words and phrases help connect ideas within and across paragraphs.
Transitional Phrases	These words can appear at different points in a sentence, not just at the beginning.
Sentence Structure	Using a variety of linking words makes writing more interesting and clear.
Cohesion	Examples include: 'in contrast', 'especially', 'however', 'therefore'.
Categories of Information	Effective use of linking words improves the logical flow and coherence of writing.
