## **Clear and Coherent Writing**

## Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is clear and coherent writing?	Clear and coherent writing means that ideas are well-organized and easy to understand.
Why is audience important?	The audience influences the tone, style, and content of the writing.
How can we organize our writing?	Organizing writing involves having a clear introduction, body, and conclusion.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking writing is just about spelling and grammar, and that audience doesn't matter.
How can we improve our writing?	Improving writing involves focusing on content and organization, and understanding the audience.
