## Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is paraphrasing?	Paraphrasing is rewriting information in your own words.
Why is summarizing important?	Summarizing helps condense information and highlight main points.
How can you evaluate a source's credibility?	Evaluate a source's credibility by checking the author's credentials, publication date, and purpose.
What are the steps to gather information?	Steps to gather information: identify sources, take notes, summarize/paraphrase, list sources.
What is plagiarism?	Plagiarism is using someone else's work as your own without giving credit.
