What is the standard?	This standard involves comparing information from different types of sources.
Why is comparing sources important?	It helps students develop critical thinking by understanding different perspectives and details.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking all sources are equal and multimedia is always better.
How can we evaluate sources?	Evaluating sources involves checking credibility, authorship, and evidence.
