What is absolute value?	Absolute value is the distance of a number from zero on the number line.
How do you order rational numbers?	To order rational numbers, compare their positions on the number line.

What are common misconceptions about rational numbers?	Students often think a larger negative number is greater than a smaller one and confuse absolute value with positive/negative signs.
