Cues	Notes
Key individual	A key individual, event, or idea can be introduced at any point in the text.
Event	Illustrations help to clarify or expand on the key elements.
Idea	Elaborations provide more detail and depth to the key elements.
Introduction	Examples and anecdotes can be implicit and woven into the narrative.
Illustration	Analyzing how these elements are presented helps in understanding the text better.
