Cues	Notes
What is the main goal of 6.RL.10?	The main goal is to read and comprehend literature proficiently.
What types of literature should students read?	Students should read stories, dramas, and poems. A common misconception is that every word must be understood.
What is a common misconception about comprehension?	Students can use context clues to infer meanings. Understanding themes helps grasp the deeper message of the text.
How can students infer the meaning of unfamiliar words?	
Why is understanding themes important?
