Observations	Observations: Total count of data points collected.
Data Collection	Data Collection: Process of gathering information.
Tally Chart	Tally Chart: A tool to record and count observations.
Numerical Data	Numerical Data: Data that is represented by numbers.
Categorical Data	Categorical Data: Data that is represented by categories or types.
