Cues	Notes
Mean	Mean: The average of a set of numbers.
Median	Median: The middle value in a set of numbers.
Mode	Mode: The most frequently occurring number in a set.
Range	Range: The difference between the highest and lowest values.
Variability	Variability: The extent to which data points differ from each other.
Data Distribution	Data Distribution: How data points are spread out.
