What is a credible source?	A credible source is one that is trustworthy and reliable, often written by experts.
How do you support a claim?	Supporting a claim involves providing clear reasons and relevant evidence.
What is the importance of evidence?	Evidence is important because it provides the factual basis needed to persuade others.
How to evaluate a source?	Evaluate a source by checking the author's credentials, publication date, and purpose.
What is the difference between fact and opinion?	Facts are statements that can be proven true, while opinions are personal beliefs.
