How can a conclusion add value?	A conclusion can add value by providing a final insight, call to action, or a thought-provoking statement that enhances the argument.
What are common misconceptions about conclusions?	Common misconceptions include thinking that a conclusion is just a restatement of the introduction or that it is unnecessary if the body is strong.
How can you write an effective conclusion?	An effective conclusion summarizes the main points, provides a final insight or call to action, and leaves a lasting impression.
