Clear and Coherent Writing

Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is clear and coherent writing?	Clear and coherent writing means the writing is easy to understand and well-organized.
Why is audience important?	Audience affects how we write; different audiences require different approaches.
How does purpose affect writing?	The purpose of writing (to inform, persuade, entertain) dictates the structure and style.
What are common writing structures?	Writing structures vary; examples include narrative, persuasive, and informative structures.
Why is writing style important?	Style impacts the effectiveness and readability of writing.
