Properties of Operations	Properties of operations include distributive, associative, and commutative properties.
Linear Expressions	
Rational Coefficients	Linear expressions are algebraic expressions where the highest power of the variable is one.
Factoring	Rational coefficients are numbers that can be expressed as fractions.
Expanding	Factoring is breaking down an expression into simpler components.
	Expanding involves distributing and combining like terms.
