



## Correcting Misplaced and Dangling Modifiers

What is a modifier?	Modifiers are words or phrases that provide more information about other words in a sentence.
What are misplaced modifiers?	Misplaced modifiers are modifiers that are not placed next to the word they are supposed to modify, leading to confusion.
How do you correct a misplaced modifier?	To correct a misplaced modifier, move it next to the word it is meant to describe.
What is a dangling modifier?	Dangling modifiers are modifiers that do not clearly and logically refer to any word in the sentence.
How do you correct a dangling modifier?	To correct a dangling modifier, rewrite the sentence to include the word that the modifier is supposed to describe.

### Summary

Modifiers must be placed correctly within a sentence to avoid confusion. Misplaced and dangling modifiers can be corrected by ensuring they are next to the word they modify or by rewriting the sentence.
