Using Transition Words and Phrases

Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
Transition words	Transition words help link ideas and events.
Sequence	Using sequence words helps the reader follow the order of events.
Shifts in time	Shifts in time can be indicated by phrases like 'later' or 'meanwhile'.
Clauses	Clauses can provide additional context or details.
Writing coherence	Coherent writing flows smoothly from one idea to the next.
