What is the importance of connecting ideas in discussions?	Connecting ideas helps create a cohesive and meaningful conversation.
How do you pose relevant questions?	Relevant questions are those that directly relate to the topic and previous speakers' points.
·	Evidence supports your responses and makes them credible.
Why is evidence important in responses?	Misconception 1: Any participation is good. Misconception 2: Responses don't need evidence.
