What is precise language?	Precise language means using exact and clear words to convey meaning.
Why is domain-specific vocabulary important?	Domain-specific vocabulary refers to terms that are specific to a particular field or subject.
How does precise language improve writing?	Using precise language makes writing clearer and more professional. Examples: 'photosynthesis' in biology, 'alliteration' in literature.
Examples of domain-specific vocabulary	Misconception: Complex words always improve writing. Reality: Clarity is key.
