What are transition words?	Transition words help connect ideas and ensure smooth flow.

Examples of transition words	Examples include: however, therefore, meanwhile, consequently.
Examples of transition words	Misconceptions: only needed at paragraph beginnings, overuse improves
Common misconceptions about transitions	writing.
