What is the main idea of the standard?	The standard involves analyzing sequences of events in texts to determine causation.
How can we determine causation in a text?	Look for textual evidence like cause-effect phrases to determine if one event caused another.
What are common misconceptions about event sequences?	Misconception: All earlier events cause later events. Reality: Not all sequences imply causation.
What are real-world applications of this standard?	Applications include analyzing historical events, literature, and news articles.
