What is literary analysis?	Literary analysis involves examining the elements of a text to understand its meaning.
How do you support an interpretation?	Interpretations must be supported by evidence from the text.
What are common literary devices?	Common literary devices include metaphor, simile, alliteration, and symbolism.
Why is textual evidence important?	Textual evidence is crucial for supporting interpretations and arguments.
How can a text have multiple meanings?	A text can have multiple meanings depending on the reader's perspective and context.
