Cues	Notes
What does it mean to respond thoughtfully?	Responding thoughtfully involves listening to others, considering their viewpoints, and responding in a respectful and meaningful way.
How do you summarize points of agreement and disagreement?	Summarizing points of agreement and disagreement means identifying the main ideas where people agree or disagree and presenting them concisely.
What are the key elements of a thoughtful response?	Key elements of a thoughtful response include respect, clarity, evidence-based arguments, and critical thinking.
Why is it important to justify your own views?	Justifying your own views is important because it shows that your opinions are well-considered and based on evidence.
How can you make new connections based on evidence?	Making new connections based on evidence involves integrating new information with what you already know to form a deeper understanding.
