



Effective Conclusions in Writing

Cues	Notes
What makes a good conclusion?	A good conclusion summarizes main points and provides insight into the topic's significance.
Why is a conclusion important?	A conclusion wraps up the essay and leaves the reader with a final impression.
What should be avoided in a conclusion?	Avoid introducing new information or arguments in the conclusion.
How can a conclusion provide insight?	A conclusion can articulate the broader implications of the topic.
Examples of strong conclusions?	Examples include essays that not only summarize but also reflect on the topic's importance.
