What is narrative writing?	Narrative writing involves telling a story with a clear structure: beginning, middle, and end.
How do you engage a reader?	Engaging a reader involves setting out a problem, situation, or observation that grabs their interest.
What are points of view?	Points of view refer to the perspective from which the story is told (e.g., first person, third person).
How to introduce characters?	Introducing characters involves providing details that make them interesting and relatable.
What is a smooth progression of events?	A smooth progression of events means that the story flows logically from one event to the next.
