Today's Standard

K.CC.A3 - Write numbers from 0 to 20. Represent a number of objects with a written numeral 0-20 (with 0 representing a count of no objects).

Cues	Notes
What is the range of numbers to write?	Write numbers from 0 to 20.
What does 0 represent?	O represents a count of no objects.
· ·	Numbers can be used to label quantities of objects.
How can numbers represent objects?	Common misconceptions include misunderstanding 0 and writing numbers incorrectly.
