What is the standard K.CC.B4c?	K.CC.B4c focuses on understanding that each number name represents a quantity one more than the previous.
Why is understanding number	
sequences important?	This understanding is foundational for future math skills like addition and place value.
What are common	
misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking number names are arbitrary and that order doesn't matter.
How can we address these	
misconceptions?	Use visual aids and sequencing activities to correct these misconceptions.
What comes after mastering this standard?	After mastering this, students will move on to basic arithmetic and place value concepts.
