## **Comparing Written Numerals**

## Today's Standard

Cues	Notes
What is numeral comparison?	Numeral comparison involves looking at two numbers and deciding which is larger or smaller.
How do you compare numbers?	To compare numbers, look at their value, not the number of digits.
What are common mistakes?	
How can you fix those mistakes?	Common mistakes include thinking more digits mean a larger number, and confusing the order of numbers.
	Fix mistakes by practicing with number lines and manipulatives.

## Summary

Comparing written numerals helps students understand number relationships. Common mistakes include misunderstanding digit count and number order, which can be fixed with practice and visual aids.
