| Cues | Notes |
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| What is the standard? | The standard is to print many upper- and lowercase letters. |
| Why is it important? | This skill is foundational for writing words and sentences, essential for literacy development. |
| What are common misconceptions? | Common misconceptions include thinking uppercase and lowercase letters are interchangeable and not recognizing the importance of letter shapes. |
| How can we address misconceptions? | Use visual aids, explicit teaching, and sorting/matching games to address misconceptions. |
| What comes next after mastering this standard? | After mastering this standard, students will write words and sentences, improving their literacy skills. |

Summary

Students learn to print upper- and lowercase letters, a foundational skill for writing. Address misconceptions with visual aids and games. Mastery leads to writing words and sentences.
