What are nouns?	Nouns are words that name people, places, things, or ideas.
What are verbs?	Verbs are words that describe actions or states of being.
How can nouns and verbs be used in sentences?	Nouns and verbs are essential for creating sentences. Nouns often serve as the subject, while verbs describe what the subject does.
Examples of common nouns	Examples of common nouns: 'cat', 'dog', 'school', 'teacher'.
Examples of common verbs	Examples of common verbs: 'run', 'jump', 'read', 'write'.
