Cues	Notes
Who	Who: Used to ask about people.
What	What: Used to ask about things or actions.
Where	Where: Used to ask about places.
When	When: Used to ask about time.
Why	Why: Used to ask about reasons or purposes.
How	How: Used to ask about methods or processes.
Context	Context: Understanding the situation to use the correct question word.
Open-ended questions	Open-ended questions: Questions that require more detailed answers rather than just 'yes' or 'no'.
