Cues	Notes
Capitalization	Capitalization is used at the beginning of sentences and for proper nouns.
Punctuation	Punctuation marks like periods, question marks, and exclamation points are used at the end of sentences.
Spelling	Correct spelling is important for clear communication.
Proper Nouns	Proper nouns are specific names and always start with a capital letter.
Pronoun 'l'	The pronoun 'l' is always capitalized.
