What is phonetic spelling?	Phonetic spelling involves writing words the way they sound.
Why is phonetic spelling important?	It helps students connect sounds with letters, a key early literacy skill.
What are common misconceptions about phonetic	Common misconceptions include thinking every letter must be written as it sounds and pronouncing silent letters.
spelling?	Teachers can use visual aids and practice with silent letters to address these misconceptions.
How can teachers address these misconceptions?	After mastering phonetic spelling, students will spell more complex words and improve reading and writing skills.
