What are antonyms?	Antonyms are words with opposite meanings.
Examples of common antonyms	Examples: hot/cold, big/small, happy/sad.
Why are antonyms important?	Understanding antonyms helps in describing things accurately and improves comprehension.
Common misconceptions about antonyms	Not all words have opposites; some students confuse antonyms with synonyms.
