What are measurable attributes?	Measurable attributes are characteristics of objects that can be measured, like length and weight.
How can we describe length?	Length is how long something is from one end to the other.
How can we describe weight?	Weight is how heavy an object is.
What is a common misconception about size and weight?	A common misconception is that bigger objects are always heavier. Length is the measurement of something from end to end, while height is the measurement from base to top.
How can we differentiate between length and height?
