Understanding Numbers 11-19

Today's Standard

K.NBT.A1 - Compose and decompose numbers from 11 to 19 into ten ones and some further ones, e.g., by using objects or drawings, and record each composition or decomposition by a drawing or equation (such as 18 = 10 + 8); understand that these numbers are composed of ten ones and one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, or nine ones.

Cues	Notes
What is place value?	Place value is understanding the value of each digit in a number.
How to compose numbers?	Composing numbers means breaking them into parts, like tens and ones.
What are ten frames?	Ten frames are tools to help visualize numbers up to ten and beyond.
How to use base-ten blocks?	Base-ten blocks are physical tools to represent numbers as tens and ones.
What is an equation?	An equation is a mathematical statement that shows the equality of two expressions.
