| What is addition? | Addition is combining two or more numbers to get a larger number. |
| What is subtraction? | Subtraction is taking away one number from another to get a smaller number. |
| What does it mean to add and subtract fluently? | Fluency in addition and subtraction within 5 means being able to solve these problems quickly and accurately. |
| What are common mistakes in addition and subtraction? | Common mistakes include thinking addition always makes numbers bigger and not understanding the order of numbers in subtraction. |
| How can we correct these mistakes? | Using visual aids like number lines and counters can help correct these mistakes. |
