Cues	Notes
Reading direction	Understanding how to follow words from left to right and top to bottom is crucial for early reading skills.
Left-to-right	Students need to recognize that text flows in a specific direction.
Top-to-bottom	Reading multiple pages in sequence helps maintain the flow of text.
Page flow	Visual aids and consistent practice can help reinforce correct reading patterns.
Common misconceptions	Common misconceptions include thinking words can be read in any direction and not understanding the continuous flow of text.
