What is the standard?	Recognize and name all upper- and lowercase letters of the alphabet.
Why is letter recognition important?	Letter recognition is the foundation for reading and writing. It helps students understand that letters represent sounds and form words.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include confusing similar-looking letters and thinking uppercase and lowercase letters are different characters.
How can misconceptions be addressed?	Use multi-sensory techniques and matching games to address these misconceptions.
