What is rhyming?	Rhyming is when words have the same ending sound.
Why is rhyming important?	Rhyming helps develop phonological awareness, which is crucial for reading readiness.
Examples of rhyming words	Examples: cat-hat, dog-log, sun-run.
Common misconceptions about rhyming	Misconception: Words with the same beginning sound rhyme.
How to teach rhyming	Misconception: Words that share a common letter rhyme.
	Use visual aids, repetition, and sorting activities to teach rhyming.
