What is emergent-reader text?	Emergent-reader texts are simple books designed for early readers.
Why is understanding important?	Understanding helps students engage with the text and improves literacy skills.
How can we check for understanding?	Check for understanding by asking questions and discussing the story.
What are common misconceptions?	Misconceptions include reading quickly without understanding and thinking reading words is enough without comprehension.
